Name: A Randomized, Double-Blind, Multicenter Study of Denosumab Compared With Zoledronic Acid (Zometa®) in the Treatment of Bone Disease in Subjects with Newly Diagnosed Multiple Myeloma

Acronym: 20090482



Purpose: The purpose of this study is to determine if Denosumab is non-inferior to Zoledronic acid in the treatment of bone disease from multiple myeloma

Treatment Arms:	Arms	Assigned Interventions
	Active Comparator: Zoledronic acid 4 mg IV and Placebo SC	Drug: Zoledronic acid Zoledronic acid 4 mg (adjusted for renal function) IV over at least 15 minutes Q4W (n = 760)
	Experimental: Denosumab 120 mg SC and Placebo IV	Drug: Denosumab Denosumab 120 mg SC
